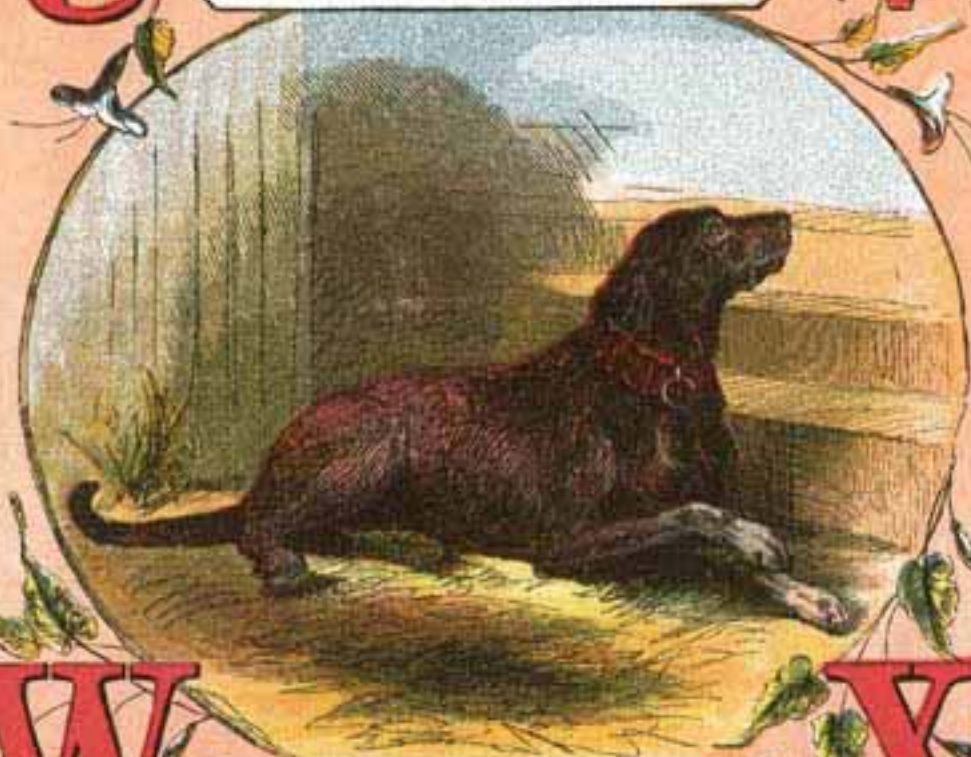
Q is the Quagga who flies like the wind,
